

Healthcare Compliance transparency reporting – Transition to company-based reporting

Placeholder / Announcement document

MedTech Europe has decided to phase out the centralized "Transparent MedTech" platform and transition to a decentralized, company-based transparency disclosure system. In line with this decision and the MedTech Europe Code of Ethical Business Practice, B. Braun will publish its Healthcare Compliance transparency disclosures via its corporate website.

Background

The company-based reporting approach requires MedTech Europe member companies to disclose Educational Grants to Healthcare Organizations (HCOs) directly through their own publicly accessible websites. This document serves as an interim placeholder to inform external stakeholders about the upcoming publication.

Reporting timeline

- Reporting year: Calendar Year 2026
- First publication date: By end of August 2027
- Publication frequency: Annual

Publication format

The Healthcare Compliance Transparency Reporting will be published as a PDF document available for download on the B. Braun website. Each annual report will present disclosure data in accordance with the MedTech Europe disclosure rules and applicable national transparency requirements.
