Medication errors in general



44,000 - 98,000

deaths among Americans each year¹



\$17 - \$29 billion

total national costs in America¹

Adverse drug event due to medication errors



4.6 days

increase in patient's length of stay (LOS)



\$4,685

in costs to the health care system per event²

Medication errors in chemotherapy



Overdosing increases the risk of neutropenic complications, which account for a minimum of €2,700 additional costs per treatment.



Complications associated with mean hospitalization costs of \$18,042 per patient.4



Consequences of intercepted medication errors

- 216 additional hospitalization days per year
- Annual costs of €92,907: €23,658 for additional drugs, €69,248 for hospital stays.⁵
