Sternal Closure today

Closing the sternum is almost the last step to be taken after long high demanding cardiac or thoracic surgical procedures. It is the last step but not the least important. Sternum closure must be reliable, easy and fast.


Over one million median sternotomies are performed worldwide yearly and the results of the closure depend heavily on having the adequate products.

Complications are not frequent but they are severe when they happen.

There are different approaches in performing a sternotomy. There is the traditional median sternotomy or the partial sternotomy that can be performed when limited exposure is adequate. **Bone Wax** may be used to stop sternum bleeding after performing the sternotomy.

There are also many techniques for closing the sternum. It may be closed for instance peristernally or intrasternally needing the adequate needle for each approach. In order to pass through the sternum maximal penetration is needed so a needle with 'sternum' point (HRS) would be recommendable whereas for going around the sternum a blunt (HRN) or short cutting (HRC) would be more recommendable.

The gold standard product for closing the sternum is steel wire (Steelex® Sternum Set) as it is a fast, reliable and easy way to close the sternum. However polyester (PremiCron® Sternum Set) is also used for protecting the sternum in some cases.




