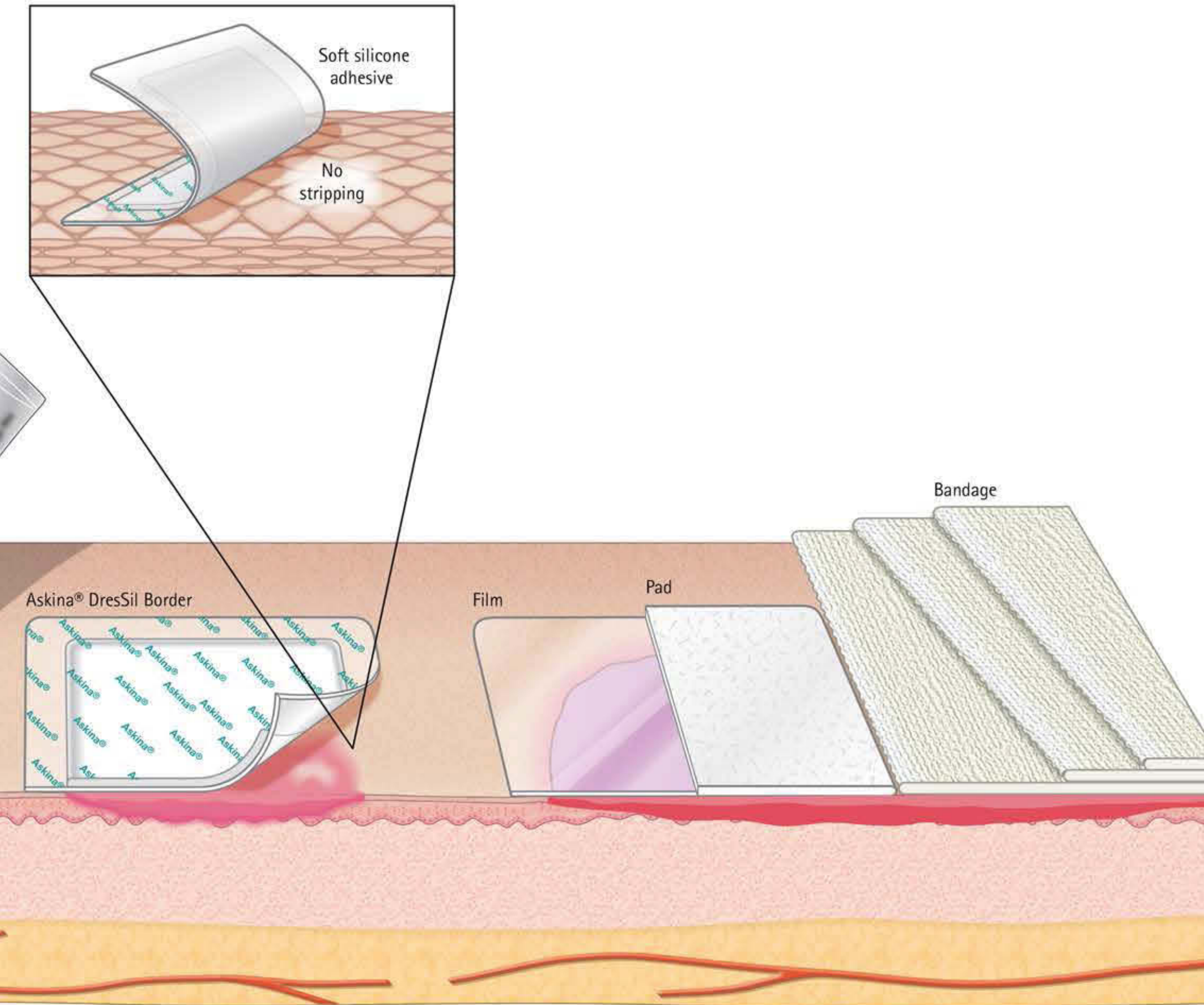
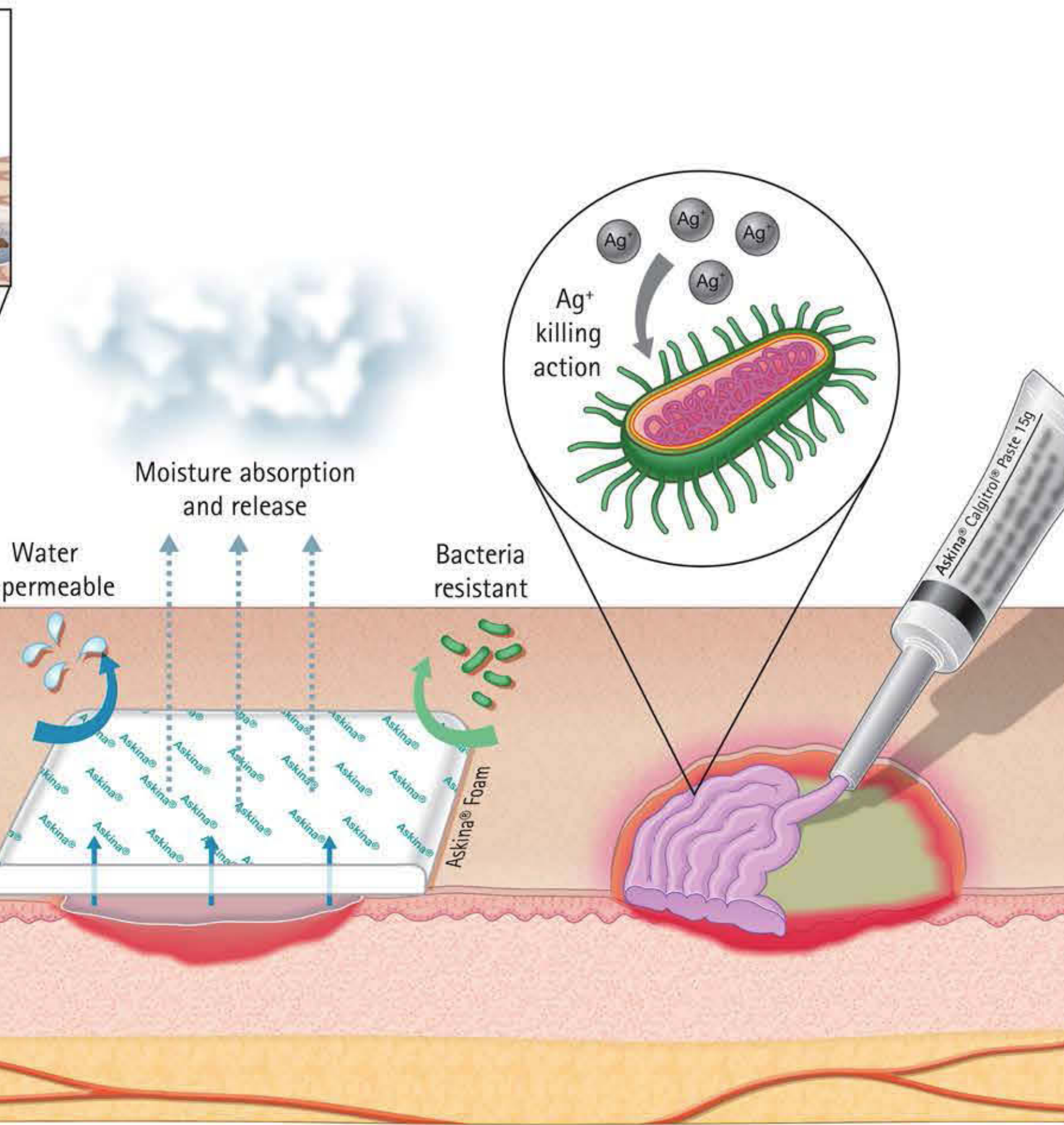
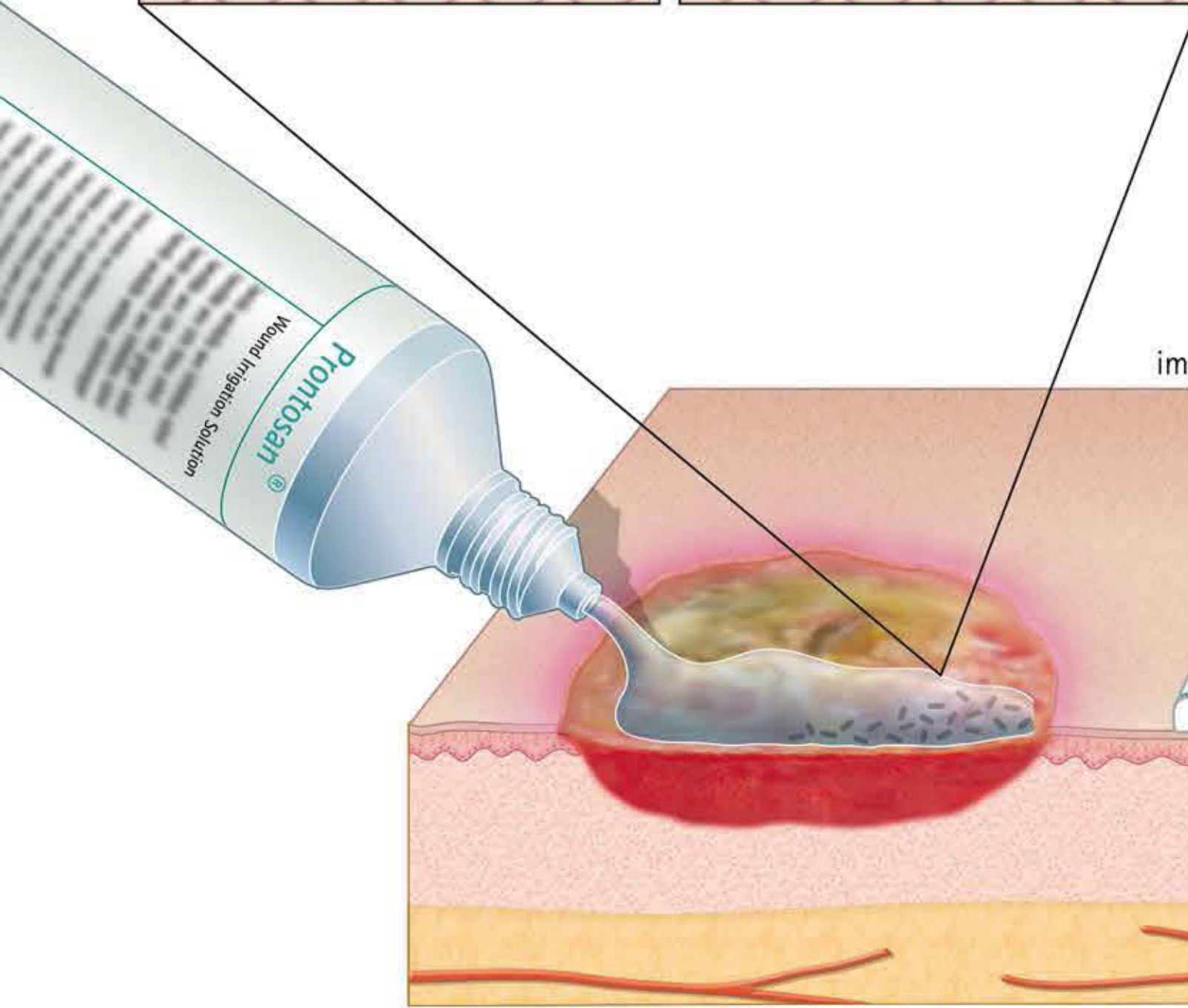
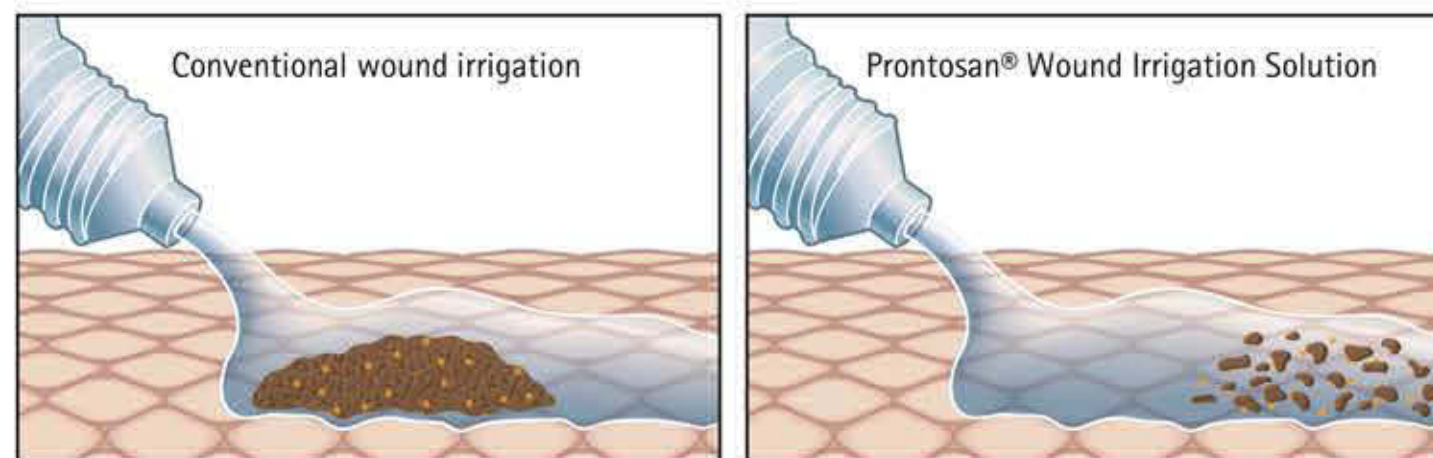
Cleansing, rinsing and moisturising of wounds

Exudate management
Maintain moisture balance

Reduce bacterial load for infected wounds

Reduce pain at dressing changes

Fix primary dressing and protect the wound as it heals



- Reduces healing time
- Removes and prevents biofilm
- Prevents infection
- Facilitates painless dressing changes
- Is compatible with commonly used wound dressings

- Absorbs excess fluid
- Promotes autolytic debridement
- Protects periwound skin to prevent maceration
- Maintains moist environment
- Promotes granulation

- Antimicrobial action
- Active against broad spectrum of bacteria
- Highly conformable allowing intimate wound contact

- No stripping of epidermal cells
- Atraumatic dressing removal
- Protects new tissue growth

- Film
- Keeps hydrogel or paste *in situ*
 - No absorption
- Pad
- Provides additional absorption
 - Prevents strike-through
 - Protects the wound by padding
- Bandage
- Safe fixation of primary dressing
 - Compression for venous leg ulcers
